<a href="#">Black Elderberry</a>	6'-12'	Wet-Moist	Sun-PS	Multiple stems, edible fruit, wildlife & birds
<a href="#">Fragrant Sumac</a>	6'-10'	Dry-Mod	Full Sun-PS	Dense multi-stemmed, fall leaves orange to red
<a href="#">Highbush Cranberry</a>	8'-12'	Moist-Wet	Sun-PS	Great wildlife shrub, hold fruit into winter, wet soil
<a href="#">Nannyberry</a>	20'-30'	Dry-Moist	Sun-Shade	Good seasonal display of flowers, fruit & fall color
<a href="#">Ninebark</a>	5'-10'	Mod-Moist	Sun-Shade	Cluster of white spring flowers, red fall fruit
<a href="#">Red Bud</a>	20'-30'	Dry-Moist	Sun-PS	Early flower, bee nectar, legume
<a href="#">Red Osier Dogwood</a>	7'-9'	Wet-Moist	Full Sun-PS	Winter color, spreading, hedge
<a href="#">Serviceberry</a>	15'-25'	Dry-Moist	Full Sun	A wild Saskatoon, first to bloom, edible fruit
<a href="#">White Flowering Dogwood</a>	20'-30'	Dry	PS	Early flower show, fruit, native, understory
<a href="#">Winterberry</a>	6'-8'	Dry - Moist	Full Sun - PS	Deer resistant, brilliant red berries through winter
<a href="#">Witch-hazel</a>	8'-10'	Mod-Dry	Sun-Shade	Dense shrub, fall flowers, popular nuts
