Red Pine	50'-80'	Dry-Mod	Full Sun	Drought tolerant, plantation pine, good in sand
White Cedar	40'-60'	Mod-Wet	Sun-Shade	Good hedge, wide growing tolerance, deer browse
White Pine	50'-80'	Dry-Mod	Sun-Shade	Good understory in oak/aspen, open grown gets bushy
White Spruce	40'-60'	Dry-Mod	Full Sun	Christmas tree, fast grower, good screen

American Larch	35'-65'	Moist-Wet	Full Sun-PS	Deciduous Conifer, wildlife food, yellow fall color
Basswood	60'-75'	Mod-Moist	Full Sun-PS	Highly valuable source of honey bee nectar
Black Cherry	50'-60'	Dry-Moist	Full Sun-PS	Wildlife food, lumber
Red Maple	40'-60'	Moist	Full Sun	Early color, good fall color
Red Oak	60'-75'	Dry-Mod	Sun-PS	Lumber, wildlife food, fast growth in good soil
Sugar Maple	60'-75'	Mod-Moist	Sun-Shade	Lumber, maple syrup, shade tolerant, good fall color

* Swamp White Oak	50'-60'	Moist	Full Sun	Oak for lowland & upland, wildlife like the sweet nuts
* Sycamore	75'-100'	Dry-Moist	Full Sun	Camouflage pattern bark, strong wood, shade tree
* Tulip Poplar	70'-90'	Dry-Moist	Full Sun	Fast growth, showy flowers

American Hazelnut	8'-10'	Mod-Dry	Sun-Shade	Multiple stems, edible nuts, wildlife food
Button Bush	10'-15'	Wet-Moist	Full Sun-PS	Showy foliage and flower, late emergence
Elderberry	6'-12'	Wet-Moist	Sun-PS	Multiple stems, edible fruit, wildlife & birds
Fragrant Sumac	6'-10'	Dry-Mod	Full Sun-PS	Dense multi-stemmed, fall leaves orange to red
Highbush Cranberry	8'-12'	Moist-Wet	Sun-PS	Great wildlife shrub, hold fruit into winter, wet soil
Red Bud	20'-30'	Dry-Moist	Sun-PS	Early flower, bee nectar, legume
Red Osier Dogwood	7'-9'	Wet-Moist	Full Sun-PS	Winter color, spreading, hedge
Serviceberry	15'-25'	Dry-Moist	Full Sun	A wild Saskatoon, first to bloom, edible fruit
White Flowering Dogwood	20'-30'	Dry	PS	Early flower show, fruit, native, understory
Winterberry	6'-8'	Dry - Moist	Full Sun-PS	Deer resistant, brilliant red berries through winter
American Beachgrass	1'-2'	Dry-Mod	Full Sun	Stabilize dunes, spreads slowly
Mod = Moderate PS = Partial Sun
